To Avoid Charges - CANCELLATION POLICY

A minimum of 24hours notice is required for cancellation of bookings without charge. Any cancellation after that will be charged for service. Notice to be given during office hours (Mon to Fri 9am – 5pm) for all cancellations. Any cancellations for Saturday, Sunday or Public holiday's services must be made no later than 3pm on the Friday before the service is scheduled.

Cooinda Community Care Service Definitions

Home Care

- Washing, hanging out /removal of clothes from line or dryer, fold and store
- Cleaning bath, vanity basin, toilet and shower, kitchen and white goods;
- Vacuuming, mopping; damp dusting and polishing
- Sweeping floors and paths
- Making beds, changing bed linen.
- Home care does not include 'spring cleaning' such tasks considered as bi- monthly or annual undertakings. Tasks do not include climbing ladders.
- Cleaning of windows will be brokered as a separate service, as will cobweb removal outside homes which is considered home maintenance functions.

Personal/Respite Care

- Washing, showering and bathing, toileting, dressing and undressing, shaving, hair care and personal grooming
- Assistance with mobility (in and out of bed) such as to sit up, to transfer to commode, wheel chair, chair or vehicle
- Shopping, paying accounts and banking where a Personal Carer is required
- Eating and drinking, cooking and preparation of food and special diets
- Assistance with hearing aids and communication devices as instructed
- Fitting and use of appliances—splints and callipers or hoist as instructed.
- Medication supervision and prompting take medication as and only if directed by the care plan. Respite care to provide primary caregivers break from care duties. Care may involve any or all aspects of both home and personal care.

Nursing Care

- Registered or Endorsed Enrolled nurses
- Shower/hygiene assessment,
- Medication checks and administration
- Wound management
